

## **DATA SHARING POLICY**

### **Reason for Keeping Records**

**The International Caspian Society** (hereafter called the **ICS**) is an organisation solely by agreement with national member societies to preserve, protect and promote the rare Caspian horse, defined by an agreed Breed Type and Standard.

**The International Caspian Stud Book** (hereinafter called the **ICSB**) exists to record, publish and maintain details of eligible purebred Caspian stock submitted by national member societies in accordance with agreed Rules for Registration.

### **Information Recorded:**

#### **Horse records**

For the purpose of preserving bloodlines, the following information is recorded In the **ICSB**:

1. Internationally agreed details of Caspian horses and their origin are registered by each individual national member society
2. This information is entered directly by, or in agreement with, the relevant national member society
3. The stud book is updated and published on the **ICS** website twice a year when possible.

#### **Owner/breeder**

1. Owner and breeder names will henceforth be recorded in the database only from national member societies with which we have a sharing agreement or which do not require a sharing agreement. Names will not be published or disclosed.
2. No personal details are required or held e.g. telephone number/address
3. Individual names will be removed upon request

#### **ICSB on-line Database**

Information required to enable subscribers to make a payment to access the on-line database is permanently removed if subscriptions are not renewed within three months of expiry.

Passwords are hashed and securely stored.
